Dear Great Pyrenees Friends,

Given the reality of our current health environment, we are cancelling our October 4th Gentle Giants in the Park. The good news is we have set Saturday April 24, 2021 for our next Gentle Giants in the Park and we expect to return, once again, to experiencing a gathering of the most Great Pyrenees at one event in the history of the world!!!

We rescued 196 PYRS last year. With our incoming, we will be at 190 this year and we are still in July. Our GPR volunteers have been nothing but spectacular. In addition to the large quantity of intake PYRS and adoptions, we had three remarkable saves this month in which our group responded admirably. A PYR puppy hit by a car, another PYR hit by a car and a 14 year old requiring immediate lifesaving surgery. All have recovered beautifully.

Dorian gets released to a foster on August 6th and he has done fantastic during his 4 month quarantine period. The woman caring for Dorian will continue to take in all breed dogs that need lengthy quarantines. As a result, our members led by Marla, raised funds and we built a permanent shelter for future dogs.

Our Stacy had 7 perfect puppies and Sabine, once again, has provided a wonderful nurturing home for the litter. The runt of the litter is named Tokyo and she may be the most adorable of all.

Thank you to all who are working overtime during this more than challenging period and thanks to all that continue to support GPR.
