GPRRA Urgent – Need Help – January 26, 2021

Dear Great Pyrenees Friends,

We have two separate absolute sweetheart PYRS that require surgeries and will need to recover with fosters. These are easy PYRS that could be perfect for waiting adopters to get first dibs by fostering.

Thor had surgery on his right hip today. Recovery is 2 weeks of limited leash walks only followed by 2 weeks of no running, jumping, playing or sudden directional changes. Then typically another 2 weeks of recovery for a total of 6 weeks. Thor should be ready to check out tomorrow.

Zeus had a TPLO on his left rear leg yesterday. He needs 2 weeks of leash walking then suture removal and 6 more weeks of leash walking with no running, playing etc. He gets x-rays at 8 weeks and then will be ready for increased activity.

We have been through MANY of these surgeries with our rescues and, basically, you just need to leash walk our PYR for the required period. Let us know if you are interested and Marla and Jenny will provide more specifics.

We are approaching 30 rescues already this year and we are still in January!!! Our foster families are like GOLD - we just need more. [Click for Foster Application](#)
