Dear Great Pyrenees Friends,

2023 has started with a BANG! As of this communication, we have already rescued 57 PYRS this year. That is correct, 57 PYRS!. We brought in 20 on Monday - two females with 2 litters and a male. We currently have four puppy litters totalling 34 puppies - three purebred litters and one mix litter. Half will be ready for adoption in three weeks and the other half two weeks after that. Anyone considering adopting a puppy or two should submit an application asap.

I know I sound like a broken record but our all volunteer team is beyond remarkable and is inspiring to observe. We found out about the 20 on Saturday and already have them in custody and in foster homes. This is an enormous effort and Sabine, Shawna and Marla are miracle workers. As always, our fosters are like GOLD and we can never have enough so please complete a foster application on our website and Shawna will make sure you have a positive and memorable experience.
