GPRA Thanksgiving Match – October 31, 2023

Dear Great Pyrenees Friends,

We have made great progress this week toward our Thanksgiving Match goal but still have a long way to go. Please [help](#). This week we are sharing Rosalind's amazing story as told by GPRA Foster & GPRA Intake Director, Sabine.

On a chilly January day, GPRA received a call from a local shelter informing us that there was a person on the way with a mama dog and a newborn litter of puppies. The mama PYR was found in a hollow tree trunk with her eight puppies safely tucked inside. One was in critical condition, and we knew immediately that every minute counted. Our GPRA team pulled it off within minutes to arrange a transport meet up and a safe foster home along with all the supplies needed. Sadly, the puppy in critical condition did not make it, but all the others were healthy and doing well. Once at her foster home with her pups, Mama Rosalind was very protective and could not be approached easily. It took us a few days to gain Rosalind's trust, but she was a trooper and took amazing care of her litter.

About ten days later, we were notified of an orphan litter of five puppies that were left behind when the family moved away and took the mother dog with them. They were roughly the same age as Rosalind's puppies. GPRA once again moved quickly to rescue this abandoned litter. We gently introduced the new pups to her, and Rosalind, a pocket PYR herself, did not hesitate to take in and care for five more puppies. She let them nurse, cleaned them up and was now a proud mama of twelve puppies! That is a lot of puppies for one mama dog to look after, and we helped her as much as possible with the clean up and some supplemental goats milk enriched with colostrum and vitamins. These essential supplies are expensive but necessary to help raise healthy pups.

Rosalind grew into the sweetest mama dog, and I think she really appreciated all of GPRA's help! All puppies and Mama Rosalind found wonderful homes too. A huge THANK YOU to team GPRA for making quick decisions to save lives!

Thank you again to our anonymous donor who will match the first \$50,000 raised. 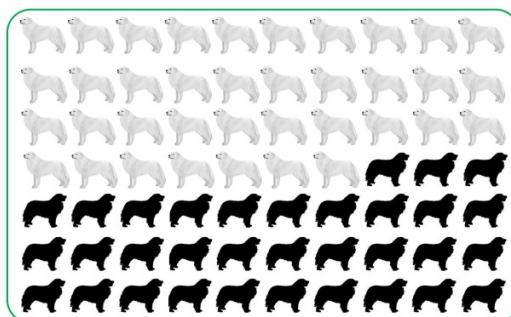
