GPRA Update – March 5, 2025

Dear Great Pyrenees Friends,

The PYRS are pouring in. We have already rescued more than FIFTY Gentle Giants this year, and we are getting multiple surrender requests daily. Our people are simply the best as they compassionately and urgently deal with not only PYR tragedies but human tragedies as well. From a woman's house burning down, to a PYR owner being incarcerated, to a Great Pyrenees being shot by a neighbor, we have come to the rescue of Gentle Giants in need.

Monday we brought in Apollo Uno, who was recently shot. He is recovering well and is with one of our best fosters.

We brought in three 5-month-old feral PYR puppies and immediately moved them to expensive special behavioral training. They are now 7 months and slowly building confidence, but still need more training and TLC. Two of them should be ready in late March. Please let us know if you are interested in adopting and continuing their training. To support this effort, we have created a [**GO FUND ME**](#) page that includes the trio's full rescue story. We were also able to rescue a beautiful Great Pyrenees father, Howl, along with Sophie, a Great Pyrenees/Anatolian mother, and their ten puppies. Sabine has lovingly nurtured them since birth, and they are all now ready for adoption. Howl and Sophie are an inseparable pair and need to be adopted together.

It's going to be quite a year, and we hope we can properly communicate how all the hard work pays off.
